INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE



HANKINSON POPULATION TREND












The Hankinson Public School District interactive dashboard may be viewed through the web site <u>https://insights.nd.gov/</u>.

The site also includes information about school enrollment, attendance and graduation rates; students' collective performance on state math and English tests; whether those assessment results have improved over the past two years; and the qualifications of the school's teachers.







Revenue and Expenditures - General Fund








